Shell Oil Company has presented the Gulf Coast Process Technology Alliance with a grant for \$20,000 to assist it in the promotion of process technology careers to high school and colleges students in Louisiana, Mississippi and Texas.

Monte King, manager of the Workforce Development Initiative for Shell Oil Company, presented the check to Ronnie Baker, treasurer of GCPTA, at the organization's quarterly meeting in League City Friday, July 27. Baker represents ExxonMobil's Beaumont, TX, refinery in the organization.

King said the award shows Shell's confidence in the GCPTA and its goal to promote process technology as a career opportunity for high school and colleges students and the organization's desire that colleges in the three state region adopt a standardized curriculum that prepares students for an associate of applied science degree in process technology.

The funds from Shell will be used to broaden the public affairs effort of the organization.
